Logline:

Emi, a school teacher, finds her career and reputation under threat after a personal sex tape is leaked on the Internet. Forced to meet the parents demanding her dismissal, Emi refuses to surrender to their pressure. Radu Jude (Aferim!) delivers an incendiary mix of unconventional form, irreverent humor and scathing commentary on hypocrisy and prejudice in our societies.

About the director:

Radu Jude is a Romanian director and screenwriter. He studied filmmaking in Bucharest and started his career as an assistant director. In 2006, he made the short film *The Tube with a Hat*, winner of more than 50 international awards. Jude's feature debut *The Happiest Girl in the World* (2009) was selected for more than 50 international film festivals. Titles such as *Aferim!*, *Scarred Hearts* and *Everybody in Our Family* followed and won multiple awards: Silver Bear for Best Director in Berlinale 2015, Special Jury Prize in Locarno 2016 and an EFA nomination for Best Scriptwriter. The international premiere of *The Dead Nation* in Locarno 2017 marked his debut in documentary film. "*I Do Not Care If We Go Down in History as Barbarians*" (2018) won the Crystal Globe for Best Film and Label Europa Cinema Prize in Karlovy Vary in 2018. His latest films, *Uppercase Print* and *The Exit of the Trains* (co-directed with Adrian Cioflâncă), premiered in Berlinale Forum 2020.

The focus of BFI FAN's support for new releases is developing diverse audiences:

- **Price**: If you have a young person/student ticket offer, why not promote it alongside *Bad Luck Banging*
- **Experience**: Research into audiences highlights how important the whole experience is. Think about promoting guest speakers or post-film discussions along with your screenings such as experts on sexual content/social media.
- Alternatively: Hire a female comedian to intro the film due to its satirical and feminist nature.
- Interaction / social media: Focus on the fact that it is a film all about loss, something that will resonate with most audiences.

Event Ideas

- Team up with a Revenge Porn organisation, such as <u>SWGFL</u> or <u>Victims of Image Crime</u>
- Reach out to the local university and offer student deals to feminist organisations, sexual health groups, philosophy department etc.
- Reach out to local university/youth groups and offer 'subsidised tickets'
- Hire a female comedian to intro the night
- Plan a post-film discussion on Romanian history/psychology/Romanian New Wave - whatever aspect of the film might appeal to your audience
- Organise a Q&A event with a social media/sex positivity expert
- Organise a 'Young Persons' audience as the themes will be particularly relevant

Planning your event

There is a regional marketing freelancer in each Film Hub region working on grassroots outreach, press and marketing, alongside a small budget for activity.
